**2.a Proposed Property Tax Levy Increase**

The tax levy process began with the estimating resolution, which was considered and approved by the Village Board at the November 9, 2020 Board Meeting. The Village is tax-capped, so the majority of the levy can increase by the lesser of the Consumer Price Index (CPI, which is 2.3% this levy year), or 5%. The levy is estimated with an overall increase to the Village and Library tax levies of 11%, after all abatements. The final levy amounts may be lowered by DuPage County in accordance with tax cap laws.
