- a. Resolution of the Village of Villa Park, DuPage County, Illinois, Approving a Contract with Davis Concrete Construction Co., of Monee, Illinois, for Construction of the 2025 Sidewalk Improvements in an Amount of \$288,352.00

This Resolution authorizes the Village President to execute a contract for the construction of the 2025 Sidewalk Improvements. The project was publicly advertised and competitively bid, with a bid opening held on April 22, 2025. The village received seven bids, with the lowest responsible bid submitted by Davis Concrete Construction Co., of Monee, Illinois, in the amount of \$288,352.00. Staff recommends approval of a resolution to award a contract to Davis Concrete Construction Co. for the construction of the 2025 Sidewalk Improvements.

- b. A Resolution of the Village of Villa Park, DuPage County, Illinois, Authorizing the purchase of Automated External Defibrillators (AED's) and Accessories from Second Chance Cardia Solutions, Inc., at a cost not to exceed \$24,719.50

This Resolution authorizes the Village Manager to purchase 13 Zoll 3 AEDs and accessories from Second Chance Cardiac Solutions, Inc. of Yorkville, IL, under the State of Illinois Joint Purchasing Agreement for \$24,719.50. The amount is under the \$25,000 threshold, but it is the second in a series of three purchases to furnish the Village with new life-saving equipment at the various places identified by the Village department heads as needing AEDs. Staff recommends approval of the resolution.

- a. 5 ILCS 120/2(c)(1) The appointment, employment, compensation, discipline, performance, or dismissal of specific employees, specific individuals who serve as independent contractors in a park, recreational, or educational setting, or specific volunteers of the public body or legal counsel for the public body, including hearing testimony on a complaint lodged against an employee, a specific individual who serves as an independent contractor in a park, recreational, or educational setting, or a volunteer of the public body or against legal counsel for the public body to determine

its validity.

5 ILCS 120/2(c)(5) The purchase or lease of real property for the use of the public body, including meetings held for the purpose of discussing whether a particular parcel should be acquired.

5 ILCS 120/2(c)(11) Litigation, when an action against, affecting or on behalf of the particular public body has been filed and is pending before a court or administrative tribunal, or when the public body finds that an action is probable or imminent, in which case the basis for the finding shall be recorded and entered into the minutes of the closed meeting.
