12. Ordinance for First Reading

- a. An Ordinance of the Village of Villa Park Amending Section 14-115 of the Villa Park Municipal Code Regarding Electric Mobility Devices.

This Ordinance replaces the existing "Low-Speed Electric Scooters" provisions in the Village Code with a comprehensive "Electric Mobility Devices" section covering electric scooters, low-speed electric bicycles, low-speed gas bicycles, and motor-driven cycles. This is a first reading.

- b. An Ordinance of the Village of Villa Park, DuPage County, Illinois, Amending Chapter 3 ("Alcoholic Liquor") of the Village Code to Revise Provisions Relating to the Local Liquor Control Commission, Alcoholic Liquor Licensing and Regulation

The Local Liquor Control Commission recommends amending Chapter 3 of the Village Code to revise the appointment, training, and leadership structure of the Commission, strengthen background investigation and fingerprinting requirements, establish new eligibility restrictions and penalties for false statements, restructure license fee provisions, and require a new license application upon a change in use of a licensed premises. This is a first reading.

- c. An Ordinance of the Village of Villa Park, DuPage County, Illinois, Amending Section 2-330 of the Villa Park Municipal Code Regarding Board Acting as a Body.

This ordinance would create additional rules for how trustees interact with Village staff. It was proposed by Trustee Konstatos. This is a first reading.

This Resolution authorizes the Village President to execute a contract for the construction of the 2026 Sidewalk Program. The project was publicly advertised and

competitively bid, with a bid opening held on August 18, 2026. The village received nine bids, with the lowest responsible bid submitted by Strada Construction Co., of Addison, Illinois, in the amount of \$133,820.00.

- b. Resolution Approving an Intergovernmental Agreement between the Village of Villa Park and York Township for GSB 88 Sealcoat Pavement Preservation

This Resolution authorizes the Village Manager to execute an intergovernmental agreement with York Township through its Highway Department for GSB 88 sealcoat pavement preservation on portions of South Cornell Avenue, South Euclid Avenue, South Summit Avenue, and East Riordon Road. The Village's estimated share of the project is \$14,252.02. Funds are budgeted for pavement rejuvenation in the CY 2026 Budget.
