Public Notice is Hereby Given that the Village of Villa Park, DuPage County, Illinois, will hold a public hearing at the date and time listed. The hearing will be held in the Village Hall Board Chambers, Second Floor, located at 20 S. Ardmore Avenue, Villa Park, Illinois. The purpose of the hearing is as follows:

- 2.a The Village of Villa Park proposes to submit three applications to the DuPage County Community Development Commission for funding through the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program.

Projects Overview

1. The proposed Michigan and Vermont Improvement Project consists of water main replacement and street improvements on North Michigan Avenue from Vermont Street to Plymouth Street and water main replacement on West Vermont Street from Wisconsin Avenue to Michigan Avenue.
2. The proposed Iowa and Vermont Improvement Project consists of water main replacement and street improvements on North Iowa Avenue from Vermont Street to Plymouth Street and water main replacement on West Vermont Street from Iowa Avenue to Wisconsin Avenue.
3. The Ridge and Roy Improvement Project consists of street improvements on West Ridge Road from Lincoln Avenue to Westmore Avenue and on West Roy Drive from Lincoln Avenue to Ridge Road.

Grant Program Overview

The Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program, which is provided by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) and administered locally by the DuPage County Community Development Commission (CDC), could provide funding for up to one hundred percent (100%) of eligible construction costs if awarded.

1. With respect to the proposed Michigan and Vermont Improvement Project, the Village is requesting funding of \$600,000, out of the estimated \$620,000 total cost of construction.
2. With respect to the proposed Iowa and Vermont Improvement Project, the Village is requesting funding of \$600,000 out of the estimated \$610,000 total cost of construction.
3. With respect to the proposed Ridge and Roy Improvement Project, the Village is requesting funding of \$600,000 out of the estimated \$600,000 total cost of construction.
