Public Notice

Public Notice is Hereby Given that the Village of Villa Park, DuPage County, Illinois, will hold a public hearing on September 9, 2019 at 6:45 pm. The hearing will be held in the Village Hall Board Chambers, Second Floor, located at 20 S. Ardmore Avenue, Villa Park, Illinois. The purpose of the hearing is as follows:

The Village of Villa Park will be applying for funding assistance for two proposed projects under the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program. The first is the Harvard Avenue Water Main Project; the second is the Third Avenue Combined Sewer Separation Project. In preparation for these applications, the Village will hold a public hearing focusing on the proposed projects and the grant program.

2.a Harvard Avenue Water Main Project

The proposed Harvard Avenue Water Main Project consists of the replacement of the existing four inch (4") water main on North Harvard Avenue from Jefferson Park to Plymouth Street with a new eight inch (8") ductile iron water main. The Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program, which is provided by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) and administered locally by the DuPage County Community Development Commission (CDC), could provide funding for up to seventy five percent (75%) of eligible construction costs if awarded. The Village is requesting funding of \$400,000, out of the estimated \$540,000 total cost of construction.

2.b Third Avenue Combined Sewer Separation Project

The proposed Third Avenue Combined Sewer Separation Project consists of the separation of the existing combined sewer main on North Third Avenue from Holly Court to Division Street. The Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program, which is provided by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) and administered locally by the DuPage County Community Development Commission (CDC), could provide funding for up to seventy five percent (75%) of eligible construction costs if awarded. The Village is requesting funding of \$400,000 out of the estimated \$565,000 total cost of construction.
